


# Did You Know? Confirmation

The biblical basis for Confirmation comes from **Acts 8:14-17**.

When the apostles in Jerusalem heard that Samaria had accepted the word of God, they sent Peter and John to Samaria. <sup>15</sup> When they arrived, they prayed for the new believers there that they might receive the Holy Spirit, <sup>16</sup> because the Holy Spirit had not yet come on any of them; they had simply been baptized in the name of the Lord Je-

sus. <sup>17</sup> Then Peter and John placed their hands on them, and they received the Holy Spirit.




The other two are Baptism and Eucharist.

In Confirmation, the Bishop uses chrism oil to anoint the Confirmation candidate's head or forehead. The Chrism is made with olive oil and balsam (which makes the Chrism fragrant!)



There are 7 gifts of the Holy Spirit that one receives when being confirmed: wisdom, understanding, counsel (right judgment), fortitude (courage), knowledge, piety (reverence), and fear of the Lord (wonder and awe).
