**Dear Parents :** This homework teaches your child to reflect deeper than they have before, and prepares for the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Please give your child plenty of time to do this. Review with them their answers and why. **If needed, please consult the chapters in the book to help them find good examples they can relate to. Each chapter in their book relates to a different commandment.** Include both sins that they committed, and/or sins where they failed to do something.

- Read page 64 & 65 in workbook together to learn about sin and how it feels inside (forming their conscience)
- Complete the worksheet below by writing in examples of where sin may have happened
- Fill out both sides of this worksheet
- If they struggle with a particular commandment, that is OK to leave blank, but please attempt the discussion.
- **It is recommended that you fill out over multiple days with your child, to deepen the reflection.**

10 Commandments	An example of where I fell short of this commandment (and sinned):

<p><b>Thứ bảy: Chớ lấy của người</b> <b>Thứ mười: Chớ tham của người</b></p> <p>You shall not steal. You shall not covet your neighbor's goods.</p>

## Questions to help Parents lead Discussion & Reflection

10 Commandment	Questions you can ask to help with the reflection (Examen of conscience)
<p>Thứ nhất: Thờ phượng một Đức Chúa Trời và kính mến người trên hết mọi sự</p> <p>I am the Lord you God: you shall not have strange Gods before me.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Does your child prioritize God and prayer correctly? Do they spend too much time idolizing games or screen time?</li> <li>• Do they focus on the right things and seek prayer each night?</li> <li>• Do they attend catechism or faith formation class and understand it is good for them?</li> </ul>
<p>Thứ hai: Chớ kêu tên Đức Chúa Trời vô cớ</p> <p>You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Have they avoided making the sign of the cross and pray before meals?</li> <li>• Do they curse or swear? Do they blame God when sad or angry?</li> <li>• Have they ever “promised to God” and did not follow through?</li> </ul>
<p>Thứ ba: Giữ ngày Chúa Nhật</p> <p>You shall keep holy the Lord's day</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Do they get upset or frustrated when they are to go to mass or spend time with God?</li> <li>• Do they pretend to fall asleep or pretend to be tired so they can get avoid prayer?</li> </ul>
<p>Thứ bốn: Thảo kính cha mẹ</p> <p>Honor your father and your mother</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Do they understand that their parents seek the best for their children (physically, spiritually, and mentally)?</li> <li>• Do they lash out in anger and do not respond respectfully? Do they try to help parents around the home? Do they spend time doing the tasks parents ask them to do?</li> </ul>
<p>Thứ năm: Chớ giết người</p> <p>You shall not kill</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Are there times where they don't respect their own body? Have used drugs improperly and or hurt themselves or make themselves bleed?</li> <li>• Have they physically hurt others or bullied others out of anger or jealousy?</li> <li>• Have they littered in the environment or failed to take care of nature?</li> </ul>
<p>Thứ sáu: Chớ làm sự dâm dục Thứ chín: Chớ muốn vợ chồng người</p> <p>You shall not commit adultery. You shall not covet your neighbor's wife or husband.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Have they tried to touch themselves or others improperly? Have others touched them improperly?</li> <li>• Have they failed to care of their own body or failed to treat it like a gift? For example, eating unhealthily or avoiding exercise or doing homework to grow their minds?</li> <li>• Have they desired to be with someone who belongs with someone else?</li> </ul>
<p>Thứ bảy: Chớ lấy của người Thứ mười: Chớ tham của người</p> <p>You shall not steal. You shall not covet your neighbor's goods.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Have they taken something without paying for it? Have they borrowed something and failed to return it or failed to return it in the same condition?</li> <li>• Have they found and kept something, even though they know it belongs to someone else? (“Finders keepers!”)</li> <li>• Have they ever copied homework or plagiarized another person's work?</li> <li>• Have they been jealous of toys and things that other people receive?</li> <li>• Have they vandalized or destroyed public property or church property? <b>Have they written on the desks at school or at church?</b></li> </ul>
<p>Thứ tám: Chớ làm chứng dối</p> <p>You shall not bear false witness (lie)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Have they been dishonest or not 100% truthful when retelling a story or sharing what happened?</li> <li>• Have they promised to do something without the intention of carrying through?</li> <li>• Have they shared information that isn't true, or gossip about others?</li> <li>• Has someone been hurt because they did not tell the truth?</li> <li>• Have they failed to apologize or correct lies that they have shared?</li> </ul>
